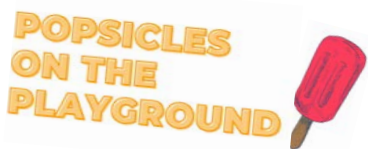

OPERATION NEW PLAYGROUND



PHASE 1: EXCAVATION

We are excited to share that we have completed Phase 1 of Operation New Playground. Over the summer the playground was excavated to level the play area to be ADA compliant. McClain Fencing & Excavating added a beautiful Redi-Rock retaining wall along with a new vinyl black chain link fence with safety gates. With the new layout we were able to relocate the toddler area closer to the school making it much more convenient for our youngest friends.

PHASE 2: PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT

We are now ready to begin Phase 2 - new playground equipment! The Playground Committee has begun applying for grants and will be kicking-off our capital fundraising campaign shortly. We hope to have the new playground equipment installed by Summer 2022.
